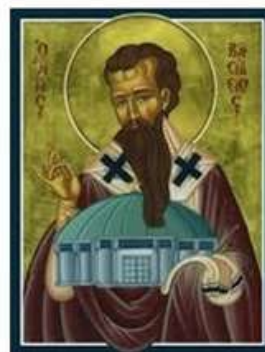

We should be at 84% of our goal to be on track.

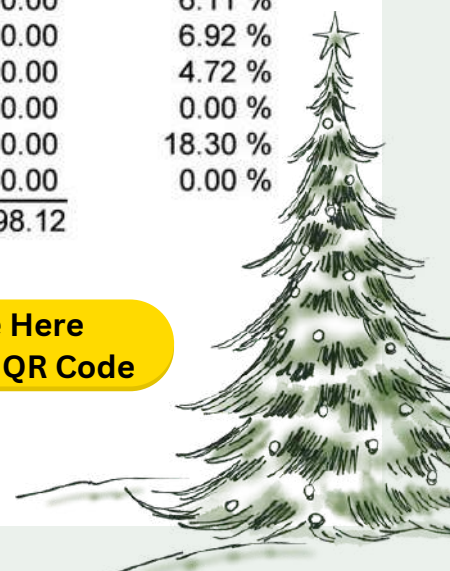

Altar Boy Retreat



During the month of November, our Altar Boys took an overnight retreat to the Saint Sava Mission and Retreat Center in Jackson, California. Over the course of the stay, the boys were able to engage in fellowship, such as playing board games inside and going outside for games of basketball, football and soccer, and partake of discussions regarding the Divine Liturgy and the service in the altar.

Along with learning more about the Divine Liturgy, the group took a trip to Saint Sava Church in town.

There they met with Deacon Dragan, who informed them of the history of the church as well as the iconography. Among the history of the church, Deacon Dragan explained that it was founded by St. Sava and is the first Serbian Orthodox Church established in America, and in this humble church, St. Sava, St. Sebastian, whose skull is among the parish's reliquary, and St. Tikhon of Moscow have celebrated the Holy Mysteries of Christ. How truly awesome it was for our own Altar Guild to walk inside an altar where the Saints have served. They were also able to meet with Father Marko, who shared some information regarding the church as well as his and Deacon Dragan's participation in the film, *Beyond the Peak*. After receiving Father Marko's blessing, and an icon card of St. Sebastian of Jackson, the group departed the church but not before allowing the boys to ring the church's bell. The Acolytes then went to eat at a diner in town before going back to the retreat center to pack up and depart for St. Basil's.

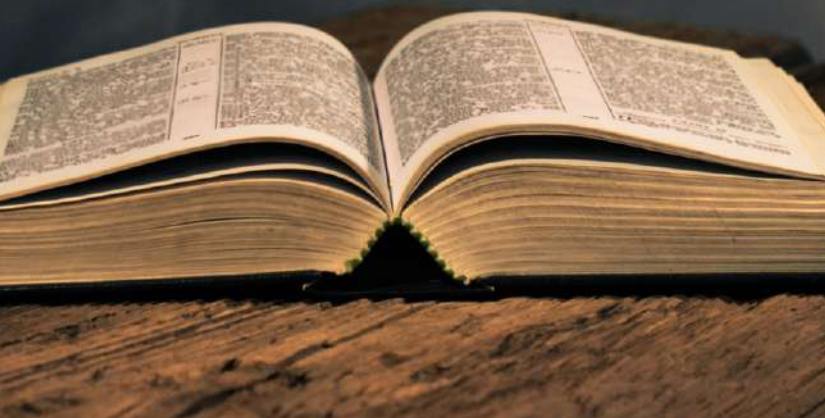
