



They remained faithful to him even during the most dangerous time of his arrest and execution. Once the Sabbath had passed, the women returned at the earliest possible moment, bringing myrrh to anoint the body. It was was this point the

Resurrection was revealed to them, and they were commissioned to go and tell the Apostles. They were, in effect, the apostles to the Apostles.




