

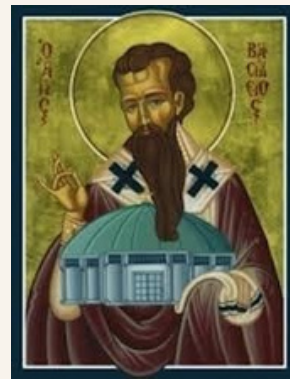

The Joy of Giving our Best Gift!

"Let each one give as he has decided in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." ~ 2 Corinthians 9:7

Beloved brothers and sisters in Christ,

As we enter the radiant season of the Nativity Fast and prepare our hearts for the coming of the Incarnate Word, the Stewardship Committee joyfully brings you an update on our 2025 parish stewardship journey. Every envelope, every online gift, every quiet sacrifice offered "for the glory of God and the building up of His Holy Church" is a living icon of the Magi laying their treasures before the Child in the manger.

- Here is where we stand as of October 31, 2025:
 - Our 2025 Stewardship Goal: \$335,000
 - Received Year-to-Date: \$252,421 (75.4% of goal)
 - Still Needed by December 31: \$82,579 (24.6% of goal)

Yes, we give thanks for the abundant generosity that has carried us three-quarters of the way! Yet in honesty and love we also acknowledge that, to remain on pace, we would have hoped to be at 83% by the end of October. We find ourselves just under 8% behind the straight-line path to our goal. This is not cause for anxiety, but for renewed awakening. The Lord who multiplied five loaves for five thousand is the same Lord who can multiply our faithful gifts today.

In these final weeks of 2025, many of us will receive year-end bonuses, tax refunds that can be planned for, or simply a fresh stirring

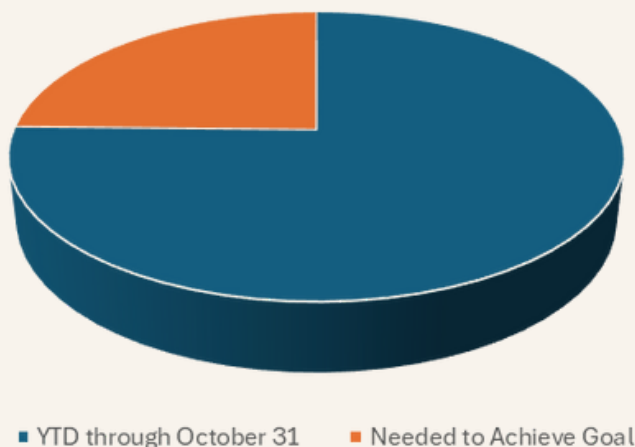
of gratitude as we light our Nativity candles. This is our sacred moment. **Two months remain—sixty days of grace—to close the gap together.**

Can we, as St. Basil the Great teaches, “give away what is surplus” so that no ministry is curtailed, no needed maintenance in our church and campus is delayed...? Every dollar given before December 31 counts fully toward our 2025 commitment and helps our parish begin 2026 in strength and peace. Let us make this Nativity season truly radiant by laying at the feet of the Newborn King the very best gift we can offer: a parish family that trusts God completely and loves one another practically.

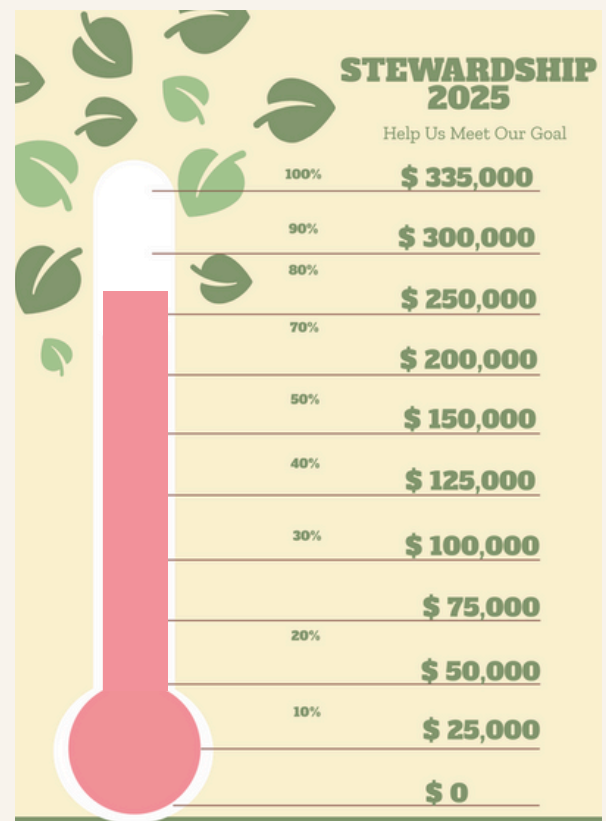

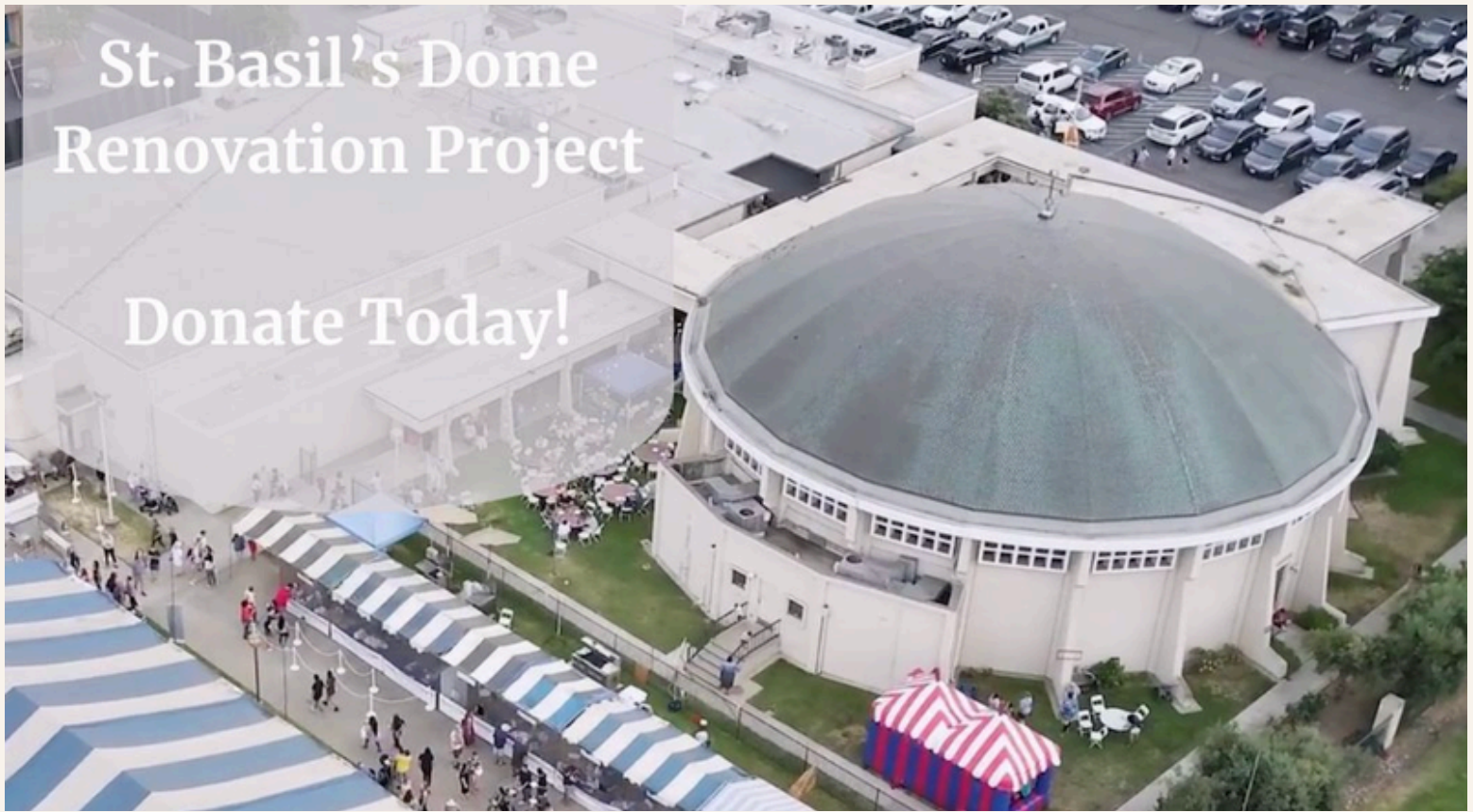

Article 7, Section 7 of our Parish Bylaws:

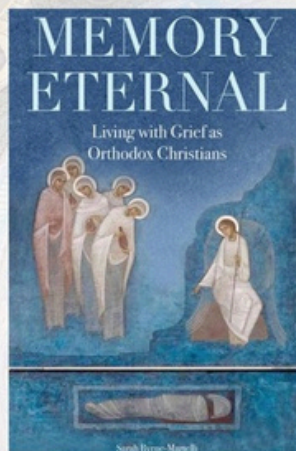

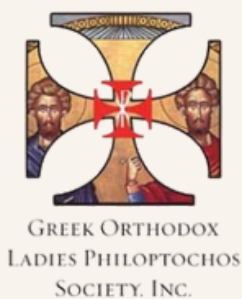

Philoptochos: Serving Those in Need with Love and Compassion

Philoptochos (“Friends of the Poor”) is a women’s ministry dedicated to serving those in need of support, whether they are experiencing bereavement, illness, financial hardship, or other difficult circumstances. It is a great joy to be able to serve people in our church community and beyond, and we would like to share some updates on our recent and upcoming initiatives, as well as ways in which parishioners can support the work of Philoptochos.

Our ministry focuses on philanthropy, offering support through sympathy and get-well cards, bereavement services, and visits to shut-ins. We also provide confidential financial aid for Parish members struggling with essential expenses.

Philoptochos supports seminarians through the Adopt-a-Student program, providing monetary and other forms of assistance to future clergy. We also support St.Basil Academy and several youth programs.

A significant new initiative is our Disability Ministry, which focuses on improving physical and social accessibility within the church for parishioners with special needs and disabilities. Thanks to the efforts of Philoptochos member Doreen Bestolarides —recently selected as an accessibility coach for one of the pilot parishes for the Archdiocese program “On Behalf of All” - we are now actively participating in a nationwide initiative to improve liturgical accessibility, create inclusive Sunday School curricula, and promote greater understanding of disabilities within our community. We have also participated in several charitable initiatives supporting those in need beyond our parish community. The Angel Babies program provided gowns to families who experienced stillbirth, infant loss, or miscarriage. Although this beautiful program is no longer active in our parish, Philoptochos members continue to honor this sensitive ministry by donating supplies and sharing bereavement prayers. This year, we have chosen to donate the proceeds from our Christmas ornament sale to [Haven of Peace](#), a local shelter for women and children affected by domestic violence. We are also planning a food drive to support a local food pantry before Christmas.

Other ongoing efforts include baking Prosforo, cleaning the narthex, nave and altar’s liturgical items, decorating icons with flowers for feast days, and more.

Flower Donations: Donations will be collected to decorate the church icons and altar with beautiful flowers for Christmas and parish feast days (Dec 31/Jan 1).

St. Basil Academy and Youth/Young Adult Programs Tray: During the New Year feast days we will be raising funds for St Basil Academy and Youth/Young Adult programs. Please consider contributing to this worthy cause.

Surf n’ Turf: Scheduled for January 24th, this event will support Philoptochos ministries and is seeking volunteers to assist with planning and execution.
