STEWARDSHIP MESSAGE



Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we approach the middle of 2026, I want to ask everyone to reflect on Stewardship. Stewardship is not just important to our Church, but it is also important to our faith. Stewardship promotes our spiritual growth because it shows accountability, reverence, and responsibility before God. As Orthodox Christians, we believe that all things in our lives are gifts from God. Stewardship is the act of giving back to God what God has given to us.

As many of you know, our Church is facing some difficult financial times. In the budget, the Parish Council put in \$300,000 for Stewardship, which is a number that the Stewardship Team has traditionally been able to meet, and we are on track to achieve as of now. However, this amount of Stewardship will still leave us with a deficit of \$135,000. As Stewardship is one of the primary, and most easily influenced sources of income for the Church, we need to raise \$435,000 in Stewardship to balance the budget. However, this isn't the Stewardship Team's final goal. I believe that having a second Priest at our Church has been a very positive thing. Yet keeping a second Priest on staff at our Church costs money. Right now, our second Priest is being covered by a very generous donor, but that money will only last until the fall of 2027. When it runs out, if we are not raising the money we need in Stewardship to cover the cost of a second Priest, then we will not be able to afford to keep one. So the Stewardship Team has made it our goal to raise \$600,000 in Stewardship. This will not only cover the deficit, but also account for the cost of a second Priest.

Now, I know that \$600,000 number can be very daunting. How can we ever hope to achieve a number like that? As an engineer, I work well with numbers, so let me try to break down this number for you. Our parish has about 350 individual adults or families that make up our parish. IF we were to divide our Stewardship goal equally amongst all parishioners, that would equate to \$1,700 per person or family. I AM NOT asking everyone to just give \$1,700. I recognize that everyone in our parish are in different financial situations, and the amount we give in Stewardship can vary greatly. So let me leave you with one last set of numbers. The median income in San Joaquin county is \$90,000, and we can use that to guide where we fall with Stewardship. If your income is higher than \$90,000, then consider giving more than \$1,700. If your

income is lower, then you do what you can to get close to \$1,700. I do want to point out though, that \$1,700 of \$90,000 is just 1.9%. Biblically, we are called to tithe, which is 10%. Our Church has traditionally asked for 2-5%. I want you to understand that if our parish gave just 1.9%, we would meet our ultimate goal of \$600,000.

So again, I want to ask each of you to reflect on your Stewardship. Compare what you give to the numbers I have provided. In the short time I have been on the Stewardship Team, I have had many individuals ask me what my plan is to raise Stewardship. Ultimately, the plan is you. Stewardship is the money that people like you give to the Church. You, the people of this Parish, have the ability to directly influence the amount of Stewardship money this Church receives, and only through your generous donations can we continue to thrive in our faith.

SAINT ANASTASIA FELLOWSHIP: ADDICTION RECOVERY SUPPORT GROUP

Dear Parish Family and Friends,

We joyfully invite you to the **Saint Anastasia Fellowship Addiction Support Group** and the Paraklesis (prayer service) to Saint Anastasia that follows, here at Saint Basil Greek Orthodox Church in Stockton.

The Addiction Support Group is a safe, confidential and supportive environment especially for those dealing with addiction—both to substances and to harmful behaviors—though everyone is warmly welcome to attend. In addition to the healing power of communal support, you will be taught patristic wisdom in very practical terms to aid your journey of healing and recovery.

The Paraklesis to Saint Anastasia, is for the entire parish, whether you attend the support group or not. It is a powerful communal prayer service where the community gathers to call upon God for healing through the intercessions of Saint Anastasia, known as “Pharmakolytria” the Deliverer from Addictions. Saint Anastasia, a 4th-century healer and martyr, especially intercedes for those battling addictions and harmful substances. This service forms the liturgical heart of the Saint Anastasia Fellowship, the official Addictions Ministry of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America. It offers Christ-centered prayer grounded in our Orthodox Faith and is often concluded with the sacrament of Holy Unction for the healing of soul and body when a priest is present.

All are warmly welcome to the Paraklesis—especially those struggling with addiction, their family members, and loved ones.




